

Brandon Township Public Library Wi-Fi Policy

- The Brandon Township Public Library provides wireless Internet access to patrons on personal laptops or other mobile devices for web and email access.
- As with most public wireless “hot spots”, the Library’s wireless connection is not secure. Cautious and informed wireless users should choose not to transmit personal financial or credit card information while using any wireless “hot spot”.
- The Library will not be responsible for any information (i.e. credit card) that is compromised, or for any damage caused to hardware or software or data due to power surges or losses, security issues or consequences caused by viruses or hacking.
- Anti-virus and security protection are the responsibility of the patron.
- Laptop computer users must be considerate of patrons nearby and refrain from excessive noise including the playing of music or movies without the use of headphones.
- The Library is not responsible for laptops left unattended.
- Wireless printing is available over the wireless network.
- Patrons may also save files to storage media and print from a Library computer.
- The Library does not filter wireless access, which is available to anyone including children with a compatible laptop computer or other mobile device.
- Parents wishing filtered access for their children are directed to one of the Library’s public access computers.
- Wireless users must comply with all provisions of the Brandon Township Public Library Internet Use Policy.
